#### What we DO NOT accept

- Talcum powder Cornstarch only
- · Mineral Oil
- Baby Gates manufactured before 1990
- Used pacifiers
- Drawstrings on children's clothing
- Car accessories such as mirrors, shades, and additional car seat head supports.
- Swaddles, bumper pads (breathable only), positional wedges, etc...
- Loose diapers in a bag. (opened in the original packaging is okay)
- Baby walkers
- Torn or damaged crib mattresses
- Dispensary items such as baby Tylenol, Ovol, Tempra, etc...
- Any item with a missing protective battery cover
- Furniture such as changing tables, dressers, rocking chairs, etc...
- Infant bath seats with suction cups

#### \*Note on Cribs\* we cannot accept:

- TEN years or older (please check manufacturer's date)
- cribs with oversized headboards (most clients only have space for small, apartment-size cribs)
- cribs with drop-sides
- chewed or chipped paint on the railings or missing screws & parts

### Things to keep in mind!

- Please consider washing clothes prior to donating. We do not have washing facilities & most clients are sensitive to animal dander, mold, & cigarette smoke.
- Due to policies, we can only accept cribs, bassinets or pack n' plays from <u>smoke</u>free homes.
- Kindly ensure that the item you are donating has not been recalled.
- Do not leave food outside overnight.
   Sadly, they get discarded.
- We accept clothing up to size 4 and shoe sizes up to size 10 in toddler.
